Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.47 dated 14.8.2015, under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D of IPC, Sections 15, 18, 22, 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, Section 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act and Section 14 Foreigners Act, 1946, Sections 3 of Indian Passport Act and Section 3 of Official Secrets Act, 1923, registered at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Amritsar City

Vide order dated 12.5.2016 this Court has granted the interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining the investigation. Thereafter, the petitioner has not co-operated with the investigation. Accordingly, vide order dated 22.8.2016 the petitioner was again directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to co-operate in the investigation but he did not co-

operate. Again vide order dated 05.10.2016 learned State counsel has pointed out that despite being specific order passed by this Court, the petitioner has not joined the investigation. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertook that petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh states that despite various orders passed by this Court, the petitioner is not co-operating with the investigation.

Considering the nature of allegations and the fact that petitioner has not co-operated with the investigation, the interim relief granted to the petitioner is hereby vacated and the present petition is hereby dismissed.
