Report dated 20.07.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Rakesh, Lekh Raj and Sumeet Kapatia as well as of complainant Karanbir Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure. Today complainant, who is present in person and has been identified by Mr. Amandeep Chhabra, Advocate received a draft bearing No.066557 dated 30.07.2017 drawn on ICICI Bank, Mumbai for sum of ₹8 lacs from the petitioner. Copy of the draft is placed on record.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, FIR No.81 dated 23.03.2016 under Sections 420,120-B IPC Police Station, A Division, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
