This order will dispose of a petition for quashing of FIR No.41 dated 07.08.2011 under Sections 452/326/325/324/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda at the instant of respondent No.2 Saggar Singh alleging that the petitioners alongwith two other persons trespassed the house of respondent No.2 armed with weapons and assaulted him. Two co-accused of the petitioners have already died. Quashing has been sought on the basis of compromise.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent by the said Court that the matter has been compromised amicably without any threat, coercion or undue influence. All the affected parties have entered into the compromise.

Following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served by continuing with the criminal proceedings, when the parties have entered into a compromise in a case where there is no grievous injury attributed to any of the petitioners.

Petition is allowed. The abovesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
