Prayer in this case is for registration of FIR under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC against the private respondent

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Darshan Singh states that an inquiry is pending before Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies. The State is not expected to wait for conclusion of departmental inquiry and if prima-facie some case of cognizable offence is made out, the FIR should have been registered. Therefore, the State is directed to decide the course of action within one month. If the State fails to take any action as requested by the petitioner, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach the Illaqa Magistrate with criminal complaint and make appropriate prayer under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
