Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Notice of motion was issued and in compliance thereof, written statement was filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5. Separate written statement was filed on behalf of respondent No.2.

After hearing learned counsel for the State and going through the record of the present case, instant writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar-respondent No.1 to look into the matter and take appropriate action at an early date. Firstly, he shall get carried out the demarcation at the site through the concerned revenue authorities

and based on said authentic demarcation report, as per relevant revenue record, Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector shall ensure that if anybody, including respondents No.4 and 5, is found in illegal encroachment on any part of the public land, including road, appropriate action shall be taken without any further loss of time.

Let Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar-respondent No.1 carry out the complete exercise at an early date and in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Office is directed to send a copy of this order to Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar. Learned counsel for the State is also directed to supply complete record of the present writ petition to learned Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Rupnagar for compliance of the order.

Disposed of, accordingly.
