Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.637 dated 4.9.2015 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 406 (added later on) registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 12.5.2016 of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation. He further submits that the parties have entered into a compromise and pursuant thereto, they have filed a quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-25996-2016 seeking quashing of the FIR in question, wherein the parties have been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial

Court to make statements with regard to the compromise entered between them and the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court has been directed to submit a report in this regard.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gian Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts and further submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 12.5.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
