The petitioner, along with his co-accused, had allegedly abducted Shamsheer, who was later on found murdered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and has been arrayed as an accused on the basis of the disclosure statement made by his co-accused.

It has been informed that the prosecution agency has examined 32 witnesses out of 40 witnesses.

Taking into consideration the status of the trial, without indulging in the appreciation of the evidence, which has been produced before the trial Court, for the purpose of adjudication of this petition, I

deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of five months. In case the trial is not concluded within the said period, the petitioner will be released on bail by the trial Court on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
