The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.53, dated 19.4.2016, registered under Sections 15/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that at the time of alleged recovery of 1 kg of poppy husk and 270 grams of intoxicating powder, the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and no other case is pending against him.

Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions but has argued that the motor cycle belongs to the petitioner.

Be that as it may, once the petitioner was not arrested from the spot, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the order dated 25.5.2016 is made absolute.
