The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in case FIR No.27 dated 22.05.2014, registered under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Khalra, Distt. Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that order dated 12.05.2016, stands complied with as the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and furnished bail bonds, which have been accepted. In support of his assertion, learned counsel has furnished a certified copy of order dated 23.05.2016, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, which is taken on record.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
