Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 06.04.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka, under Section 420 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Varun Sharma, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the case file.

From the record, I find that main allegations are against the husband of the present petitioner. As per the version of FIR, accused-Charanjit Singh came to the house of Labh Dass in the year 2013 and told the complainant that he used to send the people to Germany etc. Then Labh

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Singh gave Rs.2 lacs to Charanjit Singh and his wife, present petitioner. Perusal of the record shows that husband of the present petitioner is the main accused, who has already been arrested.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 26.05.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is now not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 26.05.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
