Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.5, dated 07.01.2015, under Sections 406, 418, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC, Police Station Panjokhra, Ambala (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 17.04.2015.

2. In compliance of order dated September 19, 2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have appeared and their statements were

recorded regarding compromise. Even otherwise, the matter involved is

personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.5, dated 07.01.2015, under Sections 406, 418, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC, Police Station Panjokhra, Ambala, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
