Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 13 dated 19.03.2016 under Sections 498-A/406 IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 11.08.2016, parties were relegated to the Mediation Centre of this Court but as per report, the mediation has failed between the parties.

Complainant who is present in the Court states that she only wants to go back to the petitioner and does not want money.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer submits that 05 tolas and 50 grams of gold is still to be recovered from the petitioner and only 04 rings have been recovered from the petitioner.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to recovery memo to contend all the recoveries have been made from the parents

of the petitioner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 12.05.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit a F.D of Rs.3 lacs before the trial Court in the name of the complainant within a period of one month. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
