Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose application for bail inter alia on the ground that the petitioner is involved in another case of similar nature in which he had signed as a witness to an agreement of sale.

With the assistance of learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant, I have gone through the police record which indicates that the petitioner has been involved as a conspirator on the basis of call details between petitioner and Shashi Pal Singh, the main accused, who had brought an impersonator Satbir Singh as owner of land measuring 5 kanals 17 marlas and received a sum of Rs.26 lacs.

The petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that he will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
