Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record Amended Memo of Parties as there is error in the Memo of Parties. The Amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 10.1.2016. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-1. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-2. The true copy of Aadhar Cards, showing the date of birth of both the petitioners, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-3 and P-4 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 10.1.2016 (Annexure-P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private

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respondents No. 4 and 5.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No. 2, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 10.1.2016 (Annexure-P-5), moved before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
