The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that wife of the petitioner, namely, Ravneet Kaur had joined the company of the petitioner-husband and a compromise has been effected between the parties. The learned State counsel on instructions states that the threat perception to the petitioner was assessed and no substance was found in the assertion raised in the application.

In view of the changed circumstances, the matter has been rendered infructuous and the petition is being dismissed as such, without assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner.

If any grouse subsists, the petitioner is allowed to revive the present petition again, within one month from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
