JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Gourav @ Gaurav Jaimes, seeking regular bail, in case FIR No.131 dated 15.05.2015, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Line, District Ludhiana.

Undisputably, the petitioner was arrested in this case on December 01, 2015. He was subjected to custodial interrogation after his arrest but nothing incriminating was recovered. After completion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court of jurisdictional Magistrate and now learned Magistrate is seized of the matter. The conclusion of the trial would certainly take time and it would not be desirable to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned Id. trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
