JASPAL SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for quashing of FIR No.19, dated 06.04.2016, under Sections 323, 324 and 506 IPC later on added Section 3 of SC & ST Act, Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 09.05.2016 (Annexure P-2).

2. In compliance of order dated 12.05.2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been observed that statements suffered by both the parties are genuine and are not the result of any pressure or coercion in any manner. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the pronouncement captioned as **Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others**; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.19, dated 06.04.2016, under Sections 323, 324 and 506 IPC later on added Section 3 of SC & ST Act, Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
