State counsel, on the instructions of ASI Rajinder Pal Kaur, informs that the petitioner has neither joined investigation nor returned any amount to complainant Sadhu Singh.

Counsel for the petitioner has expressed inability on part of the petitioner to pay any money to the complainant and has argued that the fraud, if any, has been played with the complainant by his co-accused Shinder Pal Kaur.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of this case. Petitioner having been declared a proclaimed offender and having not joined investigation despite an interim direction granting protection to him cannot be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is dismissed.
