HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, their father and grandparents at the hands of respondents No.5 to 12.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 12.4.2016 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.3, but no action thereon has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Though there is no material to suggest that the petitioners are being harassed by respondents No.5 to 12 except the representation (Annexure P-1), however, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of said representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
