This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of complaint dated 03.10.2003 in FIR No.498 dated 19.09.2003, registered under sections 406, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471-A, 120-B and 109 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion.

Learned State counsel submits that accused took Rs.1.69 crores from 25 persons with the promise that they would be sent abroad. Fake visas were handed over to them. Out of 07 accused in the FIR, 04 have been declared proclaimed offenders. According to him, no case for quashing of complaint on the basis of compromise is made out as only one accused has approached this court. He is stated to have entered into compromise with three of the victims. As four separate challans were submitted in the case and there are other aggrieved persons. This petition is, thus, misconceived.

I find substance in plea of the State counsel. Under the facts and circumstances of the case, no case for quashing of FIR or complaints received by the other victims during the proceedings, is made out.

Dismissed.
