Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 6.1.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR No.509 dated 26.9.2015 under Sections 148, 302, 149 and 323 IPC was got registered by the petitioner-complainant at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat, but no action has been taken by the police in the said FIR. He further states that the petitioner has already approached the respondent No.2 by way of representation (Annexure P-1).
