Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 24.07.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in case FIR No.80 dated 6.6.2013 under Sections 304-A/ 279/427 IPC registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar (Rural).
