The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.154 dated 04.08.2010 registered under Sections 324 and 323 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 326 and 452 IPC added later on) at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Counsel for the petitioner as well as complainant jointly state that the compromise in respect of the instant FIR has been arrived at.

There is report made by the District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana accompanied by report of the JMIC, Ludhiana, who recorded the statements and stated therein that indeed the compromise is without any pressure and coercion.

In that view of the matter I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-1650 OF 2016 is allowed.

(ii) The FIR No.154 dated 04.08.2010 registered under Sections 324 and 323 read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 326 and 452 IPC added later on) at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
