The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.8 dated 14.02.2016, registered under Section 379-B(2) of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Khilchian, Tehsil and District Amritsar.

Learned counsel contends that the allegation against the petitioner is that he allegedly snatched away the purse of the complainant containing money, identity card and PAN card etc., whereas, except Rupees three hundred, nothing has been recovered from him. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that challan stands already presented and out of ten prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

Heard.

No documents, as alleged, were recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 15.02.2016. The challan stands presented but the trial is yet to commence.

Keeping in view the totality of the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
