Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to take action on the complaint made by respondents No.5 and 6 and for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass and interfere in the married life of the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned State counsel submits that respondents No.5 and 6, who are father and mother of petitioner No.2, have made statements before the police that they will not interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners. The statements made by respondents No.5 and 6 are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further order is required to pass in the present petition.

However, in case the petitioners feel any danger to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar.
