AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for regular bail in case bearing FIR No.26 dated 27.11.2015 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 25, 54,59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

On 02.-06.2016 the following order was passed:-

“ Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in cross version case in which Jyoti has alleged that the petitioner along with Love Rattan had visited her house on the night of 25.11.2015 armed with weapons.

Love Rattan is allegedly murdered as per the original version in the FIR.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not named in the cross version case and no injury is attributed to him.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab for report regarding the evidence which has been collected against the petitioner

regarding his involvement in the cross version case.
Adjourned to 19.07.2016.”

Learned DAG, on instructions from HC Harjap Singh states that
as per the evidence collected by the petitioner he was accompanying the
main accused (deceased Love Rattan) but there is no evidence about any
specific act which may have been committed by the petitioner.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and
keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny
the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
