Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.222 dated 18.6.2014, registered under Sections 420, 120-B/34 IPC, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran received. Learned Magistrate has reported that she has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused. It is further reported that the parties have stated that they have effected compromise voluntarily and without any pressure. Perusal of the FIR shows that it was a dispute regarding monetary transactions.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.222 dated 18.6.2014, registered under Sections 420, 120-B/34 IPC, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
