By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.43, dated 12.05.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that as against the total entrustment of Rs.3 lacs, the petitioner had earlier paid Rs. 1,50,000/- on 07.04.2016. In terms of the compromise, the remaining amount of Rs. 1,50,000/- is handed over to the father/attorney holder of the complainant through counsel today in the Court.

The learned counsel for the complainant states that he has no objection in case the present petition is allowed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Considering the fact that the entire amount has been paid and the parties have entered into compromise, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
