Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Balwinder Singh-petitioner seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to hand over the investigation of FIR No.10, dated 12.01.2016, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), Police Station Moga City, District Moga to some other District as local police is conniving with the accused-respondent No.4.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has

been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied, in case, direction is given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 15.02.2016 (Annexure P-2).

5. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 15.02.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
