Prayer in this petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioners, is for issuance of directions to official respondents specially respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.3, who on behalf of respondent No.4, harassing them.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though

representation dated 09.04.2016 (Annexure P-11) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 but till date no substantive action has been taken.

5. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated 09.04.2016 (Annexure P-11) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
