Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 70 dated 1.10.2015, registered under Sections 354, 354-B, 34 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.
