Petitioners seek quashing of the fee structure laid down by the respondent-Institute and also to strike down the admission made in category I (Merit) -Rural (Free along with Category II (Payment) Rural and for reframing fee structure. The admission of the petitioners also is sought to be converted from category-II to category-I.

The admission of the said course was made in November, 1997 and a period of more than 18 years have elapsed. The petitioners and the private respondents would have passed out of their course, 15 years back and also would have also taken the service benefits in pursuance of the said course.

Ms.Amrita Nagpal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners and states that she has no fresh instructions from the petitioners and is not in touch with them.

In view of the above, the writ petition has become infructuous and is disposed of, accordingly.
