Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3.

On asking of Court, Mr. C.S. Brar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him.

Mr. Sanjeev K. Sharma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of private respondents No.4 to 6, parents and brother of petitioner No.1, who are present in person before this Court.

Though, on behalf of the private respondents an opposition has sought to be raised to this marriage.

Keeping in view that this Court is not adjudicating on the very factum of marriage and in view of the rights enshrined by virtue of Article 21 of the Constitution of India, the petition stands disposed off with necessary direction to the official respondent No.2 to consider

and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within the framework of law.

Meanwhile, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the Police by the petitioners they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.
