The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.98 dated 16.10.2015 registered under Sections 307, 353, 186, 34, 148 & 149 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 17.05.2016. But on 29.08.2016 the petitioner was again ordered to rejoin the investigation since there was complaint that the petitioner was not cooperating.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has now joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 17.05.2016 is made absolute.
