By this petition the petitioner has sought direction to the

official respondents to grant protection at the hands of respondents No.4

to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection she has also moved a representation dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-4) which has been addressed to respondent No.2 and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
