Prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that before filing the present

petition, the petitioner has not approached the concerned authorities for the relief claimed in the instant petition. Therefore, this Court is of the view that the present petition is not maintainable and is dismissed as such.
