The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.186 dated 11.10.2015, registered under Sections 473, 382 and 365 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Matour, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he along with two other co-accused forcibly entered the car of the complainant, took him towards Landran Road on gun point and dropped him at an isolated place. Thereafter, they snatched the mobile phone and wallet of the petitioner and drove away with the car in question. The co-accused, namely, Fateh Singh and Harpreet Singh have already been arrested and challan stands presented against them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that P.O. proceedings have already been initiated against the petitioner. She further

informs that the petitioner is also involved in another case bearing FIR No.98 dated 16.10.2015, registered under Sections 307, 353, 186 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at P.S. Sadar Sunam, wherein, the petitioner and his co-accused attacked the police party.

Therefore, keeping in view the gravity of the offence and the antecedents of the petitioner, no case for grant of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
