This is the second petition filed by the petitioner before this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.99 dated 15.09.2015, under Sections 324, 341, 506 of Indian Penal Code (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The ground pressed for grant of anticipatory bail is that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that a petition filed by the present petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of a compromise i.e. CRM No.M-5158 of 2016 was dismissed on 15.02.2016.

Further more the petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing CRM No.M-9096 of 2016 seeking concession of pre-arrest bail and the same was permitted to be withdrawn on 15.03.2016. Concededly, the compromise that is stated to have been

effected between the parties was earlier in point of time i.e. on 02.02.2016.

Counsel has not been able to point out and advert to any change of circumstances so as to maintain the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Petition dismissed.
