Report dated 30.01.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Pargat Singh, Kashmir Singh, Surinder Kumar and Kamal Arora as well as of complainant Naveen Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.216 dated 23.05.2012 under Sections 420,467, 468,471,120-B IPC Police Station, Civil Lines, District Amritsar and all other

consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
