AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a private complaint case bearing No. 248-1 dated 29.11.2012, under Sections 148/149/323/324/452/506/392/364 IPC titled as 'Gulshan Valecha v. Raj Kumar and ors.

It is not disputed that pursuant to order dated 16.05.2016 the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have been granted interim bail and are now facing the trial.

Learned counsel has argued that in this case there is a dispute between the relatives and lot of litigation is pending between the parties.

The petitioners are ready to face the trial and whatever consequences that are

ultimately visited upon them. Learned counsel for the complainant has accepted that this is a dispute between the relatives and that many other cases are also pending between them.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 16.05.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
