The appellants-State have questioned the validity of order of the trial court dated 31.10. 1988 and order of the appellate court dated 31.1.1991.

2. The respondent was appointed on 26.06.1976 as Constable. He was subjected to disciplinary proceedings for remaining absent on one occasion for 15 hours and on another occasion for 1 day, 11 hours and 10 minutes. The enquiry was concluded in imposing the penalty of dismissal from service on 13.06.1986 by the 18th Commandant Batallion PAP, Jalandhar.

3. Feeling aggrieved by the order of dismissal, he filed appeal before the DIG, PAP. The same was rejected on 30.10.1986. Thereafter, he filed suit before the trial Court. On 31.10.1988 suit was dismissed.
