The petitioner was allegedly found in possession of 14 bottles of Rexcof containing codeine alongwith 330 tablets of carisoma. Admittedly salt of carisoprodol is not covered under NDPS Act. The quantity of codeine recovered is less than the commercial quantity. Taking into consideration that the petitioner has been in custody and only three witnesses have been examined till date, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that

petitioner will not commit the similar offence of which he is accused of during the pendency of trial. In case of any such activity, the bail order would be liable to be cancelled.
