Report dated 17.07.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam (Sangrur) has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Sadhu Singh @ Sadhu Khan as well as of complainant Darshan Singh, Gurcharan Singh, Amrik Singh, son of Gurcharan Singh, Amrik Singh son of Mithu Singh, Manpreet Singh, Mithu Singh and Parminder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of version and cross-version and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007**

(3) RCR Criminal 1052, cross case registered under Sections 325, 323 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) in FIR No.15 dated 26.02.2015 under Sections 324,323,447,511,148 and 149 IPC, Police Station, Dharamgarh, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
