HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioners
at the instance of respondent no.4.

On notice of motion having been issued, learned counsel for
respondent no.4-complainant states that FIR No.169 dated 26.7.2016 under
Sections 420/406/381 IPC was registered against the petitioners and even
in the aforesaid case, the petitioner no.2 have approached this Court by
filing CRM-M-27706-2016 for grant of anticipatory bail, but the same has
been dismissed vide order dated 26.8.2016. Therefore, the fact remains that
an FIR has been registered against the petitioners and in fact, they have

filed the present petition just to mount pressure on the respondents-complainant.

In view of the fact that an FIR is already registered against the petitioners, wherein investigation is going on, prayer of the petitioners cannot be accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
