Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely, Hafij in case FIR No.147 dated 21.3.2016 under Sections 5/13 (2) HGS and GS Act No.20 of 2015 registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

Vide order dated 16.5.2016 of this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court in the same terms as in ***CRM-M-16824 of 2016*** titled as ***Zakir Versus State of Haryana.***

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satinder Pal, submits that pursuant to order dated 16.5.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient long time, the present petition is allowed

and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 16.5.2016 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
