This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Harbans Kaur seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct the fair enquiry in case FIR No. 43 dated March 01, 2016 under Section 436 IPC registered at Police Station Samrala, Distt. Ludhiana by some senior officers or transferring the investigation to some independent agency.

2. It has been *inter-alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation Annexure P-3 within a stipulated period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Distt Khanna, Ludhiana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated April 08, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
