Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.8 dated 29.1.2016, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ghall Dhurd, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no allegation against the petitioner in the whole FIR. The only allegation against the petitioner is that at the time when the money was given to his son Amandeep Singh, he was physically present but the petitioner was not instrumental in getting the money. He further states that pursuant to order dated 16.5.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Pritpal Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

No such material has been brought to the notice of this Court where the involvement of the petitioner is actively established. Considering the fact that the petitioner in terms of order dated 16.5.2016 has joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 16.5.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
