Matter was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this court. Parties appeared before the Forum and made a statement in following terms:-

“a. Both the parties i.e. Complainant as well as accused have resolved to settle the dispute. Complainant Shiv Kumar Sharma has agreed not to pursue the above said cases and in addition has further agreed to file an appropriate affidavit before the Hon'ble High Court and also before the Ld. Court of JMIC, Ludhiana for quashing of the FIR and dismissal of the criminal complainant.

b. Both the parties have agreed not to pursue any other case, complaint or petition against each other. Both the parties have further agreed to withdraw the present complaint and petition pending before any forum within a period of 10 days from today.

- c. Both the parties have amicably resolved their dispute without any external pressure with their own free will after having following and understanding the consequences of the same.
- d. Both the parties have agreed not to interfere in the peacefully living of each other in any manner whatsoever.
- e. That both the parties have mutually agreed that they would not initiate any Civil or Criminal litigation out of the present dispute before any authority or the Court of Law.”

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
