Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners have already approached respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur by way of representation dated 7.4.2016 (Annexure P-4), but no action thereon has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that the dispute is between the parents on the one side and their sons and daughters-in-law on the other side and a civil suit is already pending between the parties, however, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of application (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
