INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 11, since the petitioner No.2 is a lady living alone and on whose property private respondents No.4 to 11 are keeping their evil eye and to usurp her property they have resorted to criminal acts, violence and misuse of official machinery in furtherance of which they have killed an innocent person on 27.11.2015 when they tried to kill petitioner No.1 by demolishing the wall of the property in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 28.11.2015 (Annexure P-1), moved to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana by the petitioner-Aarti Grover, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the said representation dated 28.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after

receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
